



Athletic Achievement/Honors:

Head Coach for Men's and Women's Swimming for 12 years. Women's team won the Patriot League Championship in 1998, 2000, 2001. Men's team won Patriot League in 1999, the nucleus of his team won again in 2002, after Chris had moved to the Lehigh Alumni office.

During his tenure as the most successful swimming coach in Lehigh history Chris' teams won two out of every three meets in which they participated, his winning percentage for men was 69% (81-37) and women 61% (75-47). In addition to the Patriot League Championships his men's teams also had 9 second place finishes and a third. The women's team had one second place and three third place finishes.

Chris recruited and developed 115 scholar athletes, men and women, into individual Patriot League Champions. In addition, 74, both men and women, earned recognition as All Patriot League. He had three men and one woman who were recognized as Patriot League
